

INTERNAL ACADEMIC AUDIT REPORT 2021-2022

The Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC), Islamiah College (Autonomous), Vaniyambadi has started the practice of conducting Internal Academic Audit (IAA) since the Academic Year 2014-15. Dr. K. Anandaratchagan, Associate Professor of Chemistry and Dr.T.Afsar Basha, Dean and Associate Professor of Commerce were appointed as Internal Academic Auditors from the Academic Year 2018-19. The present IAA report has been prepared by Internal Auditors for the Academic Year 2021-22 i.e from 01.06.2021 to 31.05.2022 covering, two semesters of the academic year. This IAA report is submitted as per the IQAC criteria encompassing all important parameters. The IAA was conducted on 23rd & 24th June 2022.

During IAA, the Internal Auditors personally visited all the Academic Departments and Units of Students Support Services to verify the records and collect the required information. Even though the academic year is interrupted due to Covid-19 both Academic Departments and Units of Students Support Services have carried out various activities. On the basis of the information provided by the respective Departments, this Internal Academic Audit report has been prepared. It is presented here very briefly in two parts. The first part covers the activities of Academic Departments and the second part deliberates on the activities carried out by the Units of Students Support Services during the Academic Year 2021-22.

ACTIVITIES OF ACADEMIC DEPARTMENTS

1. Report on students' Attendance:

The students' attendance is maintained as per the college rules and regulations for all the departments in the college office. DEPARTMENT OF LIBRARY AND INFORMATION SCIENCE

The Library was established in the formative years of the College. The College witnessed the Library crossing one milestone after another to become a mammoth monolith with a collection exceeding **83,000** books on its shelves. The Library houses not only the subject books but also rare collections of philosophy, logic, politics and languages. The Library functions on the basis of Open Access System in which the students and staff have facilities for unlimited usage of the treasure trove.

The College provides ample scope and opportunity to the students to read and learn a lot from a wide spectrum of newspapers, magazines and periodicals available in the Reading Room. The College subscribes **110** National and international periodicals and 8 newspapers. We have back volumes (Journals) **3036**, M.Phil., Dissertations **906**, Ph.D. Theses **154** and CD/DVD **575**.

The College has a video cassettes and CDs relevant to curriculum. For the benefit of the staff, postgraduate students and research scholars, the Library has a Computer Centre with internet facility. The College has been subscribing more than 70,00,000 e-books and 6000+ e-journals through INFLIBNET & DELNET. The Library has NPTEL e-learning video courses, and also provides DSpace for College Repository system.

The Reference Section of the Library quenches the scientific thirst of the scholars of host and surrounding institutions. The Library has Reprographic facility WiFi enabled and fully automated by SOUL 2.0 software and all books are bar-coded. A multi facility Virtual Library was launched on 28th August 2021. It includes Projector, SWAYAM PRABHA channel with DISH ANTENNA, Headphone and UPS facility.

Library Hand Book - A User Manual highlighting "How to make use of Library Resources including e-Resources" is readily available and distributed to all Students and Staffs'. They are trained by the Librarian through orientation Programmes at regular interval of time. This is one of the best practices of the Library.


STUDENTS GRIEVANCES REDRESSAL COMMITTEE
