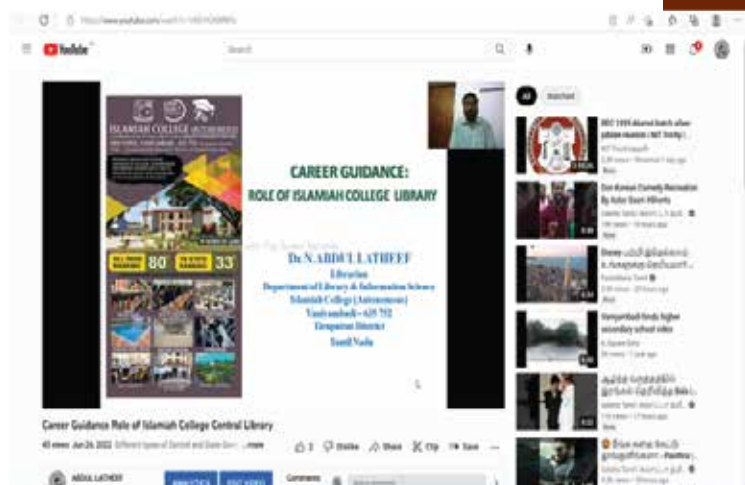
## AYINA: ANNUAL YOUNG INNOVATOR NURTURE AWARD

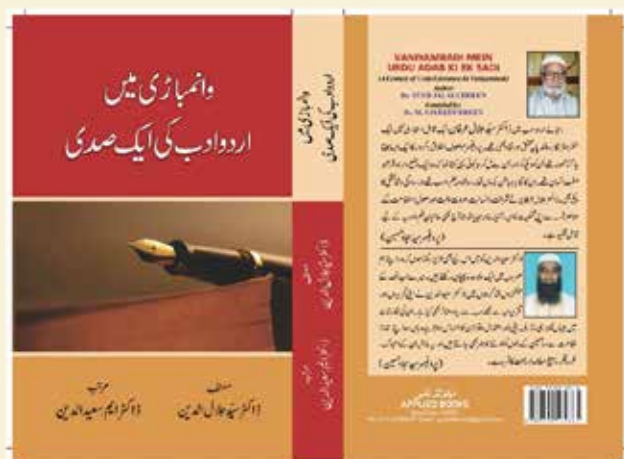

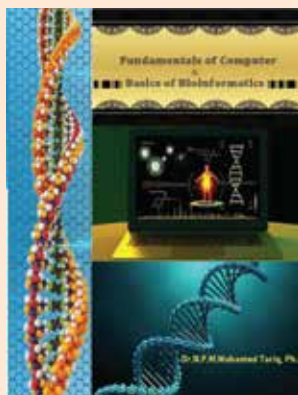

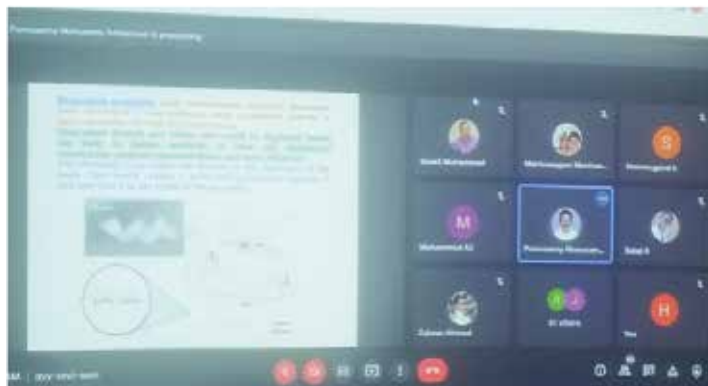
### DEPARTMENT OF BUSINESS ADMINISTRATION

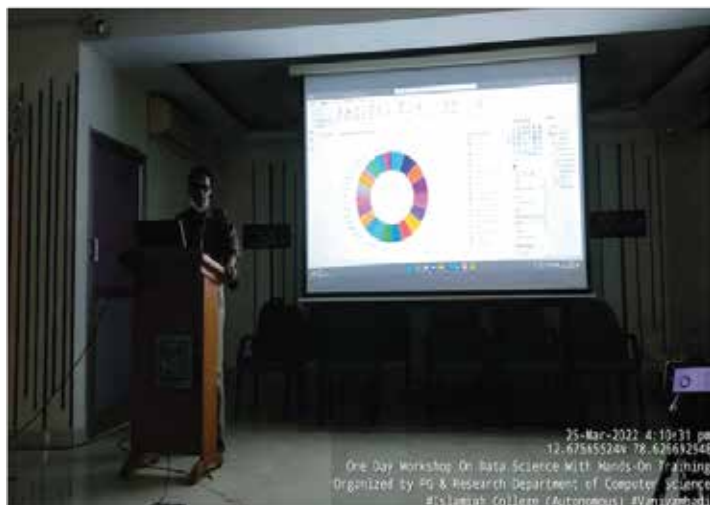
### DEPARTMENT OF BIOCHEMISTRY

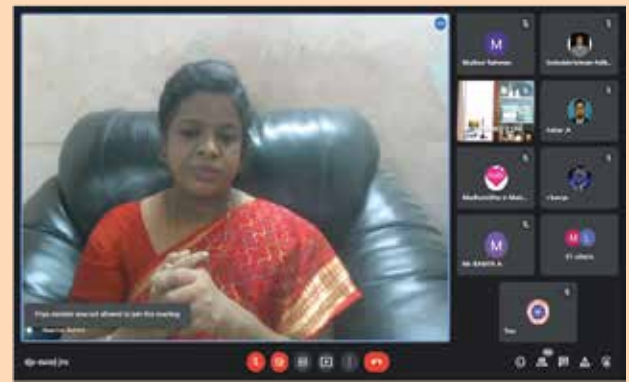
