Analysis Report of Students' Feedback for the Academic Year 2021-22

The Students' Overall Feedback, for the Academic Year 2021-22, was collected through Google Form during May 2022. A well structured Online Feedback Form was administered to collect the Students' Feedback among all the Undergraduate and Postgraduate Students. 1509 students responded to the Feedback Form (Google Form). The following are the important findings and observations:

Findings and Observations

- ✓ Out of the 1509 students, 36.1% belonged to First Year Undergraduate Programmes. 32.2% of the respondents belonged to Third Year Undergraduate Programmes.
- ✓ 21.2% of the respondents were from Computer Science Department and 14.6% were from Commerce Department.
- ✓ According to 55.6% of the respondents, Teachers' Preparation for the Classes was very well and according to 28.6% of the students, teachers were well prepared.
- ✓ Teacher's approach to teaching can be described as excellent for 48.2% of the respondents, very good for 25.6% and good for 22.6% of the respondents.
- ✓ A vast majority of the students felt that teachers' communicate effectively.
- ✓ 68.8% of the respondents opined that teachers are always helpful and advise quite often.
- ✓ A vast majority of the students opined that the prescribed materials for the subjects are easily available.
- ✓ Most of the students have acknowledged the use of Student Centric Methods of Teaching.
- ✓ A huge majority of the students rated internal evaluation process as fair.
- ✓ Most of the students have said that teachers have informed about the expected competencies, course outcomes and programme outcomes.

- ✓ A huge percentage of students (Approx. 85%) agree that Teaching and Mentoring Process of the institution facilitates in overall development.
- ✓ A vast majority of the students agree that the College provides multiple opportunities to learn and grow.
- ✓ For most of the students, mentor does a necessary follow-up for the assigned tasks.
- ✓ A great majority of the student respondents said that teachers illustrate the concepts through examples and applications usually or every time.
- ✓ Most of the students agree that teachers identify student's strength and encourage them. Similarly, most of the students strongly agree that teachers identify the weakness of students and help them to overcome.
- ✓ A vast majority of the students agree that the College is taking effort to engage students in monitoring, reviewing and continuous quality improvement of the teaching learning process.
- ✓ A significant percentage of students have acknowledged the use of ICT tools while teaching.
- ✓ A great majority (Approx. 80%)of the students agree that teachers use different methods of teaching for enhancing learning experiences.
- ✓ A huge percentage (Approx. 80%) of students acknowledge that efforts are made by the institution/teachers to inculcate Soft Skills, Life Skills and Employability Skills to make you ready for the world of work
- ✓ Highly significant percentage of students has acknowledged that the overall Quality of Teaching-Learning Process in the institution as very good.
- ✓ The services of the College Office (Approx. 90%) and Office of the COE (Approx. 96%) has been described as Excellent or Very Good or Good by vast majority of students.

Suggestions

Based on the above findings and observations, the following suggestions were made by IQAC to further enhance the Quality of Teaching and Learning Experiences:

✓ To suggest newly recruited/young staff members to use ICT Facilities in all theory classes to enhance Learning Experiences of Students.

Conclusion

The above findings and observations show that the Curriculum of various Programmes, Teaching Methodologies adopted by Faculty Members, Faculty Competency, Academic Infrastructural Facilities etc., are more than adequate for the Holistic Development of the Students.
